YEAR B - WEDNESDAY OF HOLY WEEK

O God, make speed to save me. O Lord, make haste to help me. Greetings to you on this Wednesday of Holy Week. Christ came down to awaken the Anointed, to show us how to strip off our filthy and impure garments, and return to our heavenly home. For those who lived at the time, Christ came in a physical manifestation, an example of how perfect we can be while existing here in the cosmos. For those of us not graced with Christ's physical, living example, it is his word which lives for and in us.

Therefore, now that we are awakened here, we must begin living a perfect life here. Because we have been anointed, awakened, this does not mean we are no longer under the sway of the demiurge and his malevolent forces. In our Gospel we see that Judas, an Apostle who had been given the power to cast out demons and unclean spirits, still fell beneath the influence of Satan, the lord of the cosmos. Baptism cleans and purifies, but it does not make us eternally perfect. We continue to sin afterwards for we are fallible in our humanity. This is why we regularly partake of the Eucharist. We are cleansed and purified every week with this Communion.

Remember, Christ alone was able to defeat death, because he was perfect. So perfect that he willfully welcomed death; death of his physical body, because he knew that it is only the divine Spirit within which is truly alive and cannot die.

So do not be weary or lose heart. God, in His infinite love, has sent forth a Living Word to guide and defend us. Let us glorify him in life, as he was glorified in death.
